(Indianapolis, Indiana) – September 27, 2006

It was a challenge roughing in exact locations for the electrical, security, life safety, temperature control and security devices because 80% of this project was either concrete block, poured concrete or pre-cast concrete.

The first team installed all the conduit and boxes for electrical, security, temperature control, voice and data, and life safety systems. The second team was the metal stud rough-in and wire team. And the third team was responsible for the entire security automation, access control, watchtour, duress, fire alarm, video visitation and audio/video communication systems.

These teams successfully worked together to overcome a union strike and extreme weather delays to complete this project as scheduled.
